he Art and Culture Center/ Hollywood presents contemporary gallery exhibitions, live stage performances, and award-winning education programs in the visual and performing arts at three unique facilities in downtown Hollywood. The Center's mission is to cultivate creativity and the support of the arts in our community through education, innovation, and collaboration.

The Art and Culture Center/ Hollywood is pleased to announce that 24 artists have been selected to participate in the upcoming 2022 Florida Biennial. This 11th edition of the Center's Biennial was juried by Ylva Rouse, Senior Curator at MOCA Jacksonville. Rouse reviewed over 1,000 submitted works from 349 artists from cities throughout Florida. From the large number of submissions, 24 artists, representing eight Florida counties were selected by Rouse.

The exhibition is organized by the Center's Curator Meaghan Kent, and will be on view from October 15, 2022 through February 5, 2023.

Through a plethora of mediums, from site-responsive installations, video, painting, sculpture, and photography, to conceptual art – the artists in the exhibition will address themes that are often directly, or sometimes more loosely connected to the world and current events, as well as general themes that define the recent developments and significant changes of our era.

One of the artists will also be selected for a solo exhibition next year (2023).

This year's exhibition is being judged by Ylva Rouse, who currently serves as Senior Curator at the Museum of Contemporary Art in Jacksonville, Florida, overseeing the exhibitions and collection of the institution. Ylva is joined by Curator, Meaghan Kent, who is Curator of Exhibitions at the Art and Culture Center/Hollywood. She is the Founder of Site95, an organization that holds exhibitions in available spaces including Locust Projects, Abrons Arts Center, and public outdoor spaces in Miami and New York.

early detection and disease deterrent lifestyles help transform and save lives. Delayed, or missed screenings could lead to disease diagnosed at a later stage with poorer outcomes, but with partners like Hollywood Kia, our community outreach makes a difference."



A leader in fostering healthy communities, WBHI was recently designated the first official Florida license plate designed to support Disease Prevention & Early Detection. Pre-sale vouchers are available at flbreasthealth.com/licenseplate to provide increased education and awareness relating to early detection, prevention, and screening of breast and heart issues. Voucher pre-orders will be available during the exclusive community event at Hollywood Kia on October 12th.

During the event at Hollywood Kia, WBHI will also offer a series of heart screenings including cholesterol, hypertension, and glucose. In addition, educational tools will be provided with information to help reduce risk, manage levels, and promote early detection, while modeling a healthy lifestyle.

Holocaust Education & Documentation Center Hosts Deadly Medicine: Creating the Master Race



he Holocaust Documentation & Education Center (HDEC) was created in 1980. Its Founders, the late Arnold Picker, and Abe Halpern envisioned the HDEC as "A Living Memorial through Education" – through the collecting and archiving of Holocaust eyewitness oral history testimonies (Oral History Collection). From its inception, the mission of the HDEC was embraced in its name: to document and educate.

The Founding President, the late Sister Trinita Flood of Barry University, invited every South Florida College and University president to join the Board of Directors. This remarkable partnership still continues today. They are currently exhibiting an intensive presentation: The Deadly Medicine: Creating the Master Race Exhibition explores the history of eugenics and the inhumane, criminal practices the Nazi Party utilized between 1933-1945.

The Nazis, fueled by a genocidal ideology, aimed to eliminate those they deemed "life unworthy of life." The Nazis and the medical professionals who furthered this ideology began with forced sterilizations and escalated to the "Euthanasia" Programs and Aktion T4 program, the goals of which were experimentation and mass murder.

This Exhibition highlights many of these physicians, including Josef Mengele, known as the "Angel of Death," who experimented on twins. These murderous practices left a mark on the medical field forever, including on medical ethics and social responsibility today. Deadly Medicine: Creating the Master Race walks us through this dark part of history and reminds us to continue the fight never to let it happen again.

The exhibit is free of charge for visitors. The museum also offers the ability to tour this exhibition using QR code scanning. Bring your smartphone and headphones to be able to take advantage of this feature. The exhibit will be open until September 15, 2022.

STUDENTS ARE WELCOMED TO SCHOOL with Increased Security Measures

Broward County Public Schools (BCPS) welcomed students back to the classroom on Tuesday, August 16th. Students styled their favorite lunch boxes and proudly carried new binders in their backpacks as they rode on one of the county's 1,000 school buses.



The children may be less aware of a number of changes at Broward's schools that are less visible.

Several upgraded security measures have been implemented this year. These include technology upgrades and increased security personnel at each county school. Students and faculty will continue to be required to wear their student identification lanyards throughout the day. Some of the new security measures, however, won't be quite as visible.

"Many cameras throughout our schools have been upgraded. Enhancing those cameras from analog to digital and also having additional security measures as you come into the school as you're entering the schools (were a priority)," said Jaime Alberti, BCPS's new Chief Safety and Security Officer. "It's not just about the technology but also about ensuring that we have the personnel that supports the schools and provides additional security at that school."

A critical aspect of preventing tragedies like the one at Stoneman Douglas High School is identifying threats before they do something horrible. The 2022/23 school year will be the first year the county's Behavioral Threat Assessment Department will be active. The department will coordinate and implement the school system's newly revised Behavioral Threat Assessment (BTA) Procedures.

BTA Procedures incorporate the most updated recommendations from national leaders in threat assessment, including the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), the U.S. Secret Service, and the Virginia Department of Criminal Justice Services (DCJS). With the goal of maintaining safe and secure schools, the County's Behavioral Threat Assessment Procedures Manual outlines and provides guidance to school and district staff on the most current threat assessment policies and procedures for Broward County Public Schools.

MESSAGE FROM THE MAYOR



As summer vacation ends and children head back to school, we will

be sharing the road with students, buses, and bicyclists. It's an important time to remind everyone to slow down and pay attention. The Hollywood Police Department has the following reminders from Florida Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles.

MOTORISTS AND SCHOOL BUS SAFETY

- All drivers moving in either direction on a two-way street or highway with paved median must stop for a school bus displaying a stop signal, and must remain stopped until the road is clear of children AND the school bus stop arm is withdrawn.
- Motorists on a highway divided by a raised barrier or unpaved median driving in the opposite direction do not have to stop for the bus, but should slow down and watch for students.
- Be alert and watch for children, especially near schools, bus • stops, school buses, and in school parking lots.
- Pay extra attention to lower speed limits in school zones.
- Watch for and obey signals from school crossing guards. •
- Only drive or park in authorized areas to drop off or pick up children at school.

SCHOOL ZONE SPEEDING

- Fines are doubled for speeding in a school zone.
- Special speed limit signs are posted around schools to alert you as you enter the zone.
- School buses will also be entering or exiting the school.
- Keep your focus on driving and make other activities secondary.
- Be alert and pay attention to the flashing speed limit sign, the stopped school bus, or the construction ahead sign.


